

SEDAR® Subscriber Update

September 14, 2009

Code Update (Version 008.012.000)

A SEDAR code update is scheduled for Monday, September 21, 2009.

You are encouraged to obtain the code update as soon as possible on or after September 21, 2009 by following these procedures:

1. Start the SEDAR program;
2. Select File menu; and
3. From the File menu, select Receive items from SEDAR server.

This method will help make sure that the application is updated and ready for your use before you actually have to perform any business functions.

This code update will bring the SEDAR client application up to Version 008.012.000.

Once the code update has been downloaded, close the SEDAR program and follow the instructions below to execute the code update:

1. Click the Start button located at the bottom left corner of the screen;
2. Select Programs; and
3. From the Program menu, select SEDAR and then select Code Update.

NOTE: TMP Filings

All filings that have been saved but not submitted (shown as TMP on your Filing Management screen) should be either submitted by Friday, September 18, 2009 or deleted. To delete any TMP filings, highlight the project and select File/ Remove Unsubmitted Filing(s).

Summary of Code Update Changes

1. Blacklined Documents

Blacklined documents contained within the following filing types will now have the access level "Private-Nonpublic". A new access level "Private-Nonpublic-Incorrect" has been created to identify any document with the current "Private-Nonpublic" access level as an incorrect filing. SEDAR will not allow any document with either of these access levels to be made public.

2. Formal Correspondence

The formal correspondence document "Notice of Filing" is being deleted. Historical filings will continue to reflect this document type where applied.

3. Subtype

The subtype "Acknowledgement to Evidence Redemption by a Receipt" is being corrected to "Acknowledgement to Evidence Exemption by a Receipt". Historical filings will now reflect the corrected name.

4. Adobe Acrobat 9.0

SEDAR will now allow filers to submit PDF documents that were created using the Adobe Acrobat Exchange 9.0 software.

5. SEDAR Help

The SEDAR Help files have been updated to remove all references to MRRS and reflect the Passport System.

6. Commission Fee Description Changes

Northwest Territories Securities Office

The Northwest Territories Securities Office fee schedule was amended effective June 24, 2009. The changes to the schedule are to make a distinction between charging per class of security for a non-mutual fund issuer's prospectus and charging per fund for a mutual fund issuer's prospectus, including any amendments.

New Brunswick Securities Commission

Effective September 21, 2009, the New Brunswick Securities Commission will implement an updated fee schedule on SEDAR. The Commission has amended its fee schedule to no longer require a filing fee for a material change report.

Autorité des marchés financiers

The Québec fee table has been modified in order to add the description of the fees payable when a filing by the offeror of the documents or the advertisement provided for under a foreign take-over or issuer bid exemption or a de minimis exemption prescribed by regulation.

Previous Issuers

Changes have been made to www.sedar.com with respect to the display order of previous filer profiles that are linked to the new filer profile. The document page for the new filer will display the documents for the previous filers in **descending** filer number order.

For example:

Issuer C (filer number 00123456) is the new filer
Issuer B (filer number 00011111) is a previous filer linked to Issuer C
Issuer A (filer number 00001234) is a previous filer linked to Issuer C

Issuer C's documents will continue to be displayed at the top of the document list. Issuer B's profile link and documents will display beneath Issuer C's as Issuer B's profile number is closest in descending order followed by Issuer A's profile link and documents.
