

SEDAR® Subscriber Update

June 17, 2004

Code Update (Version 007.001.017)

A SEDAR code update is scheduled for Monday, June 21, 2004. Its size is approximately 2.46 MB and should take approximately 7 minutes to download using a 28.8K modem.

You are encouraged to obtain the code update as soon as possible on or after June 21, 2004 by following these procedures:

1. Start the SEDAR program;
2. Select File menu; and
3. From the File menu, select Receive items from SEDAR server.

This method will help make sure that the application is updated and ready for your use before you actually have to perform any business functions.

This code update will bring the SEDAR client application up to Version 007.001.017.

Please be patient and **allow the download to complete before proceeding**. Once the code update has been downloaded, close the SEDAR program and follow the instructions below to execute the code update:

1. Click the Start button located at the bottom left corner of the screen;
2. Select Programs; and
3. From the Program menu, select SEDAR and then select Code Update.

Summary of Code Update Changes

1. Autorité des marchés financiers

Since February 1st, 2004, the Commission des valeurs mobilières du Québec has been merged with four other financial sector organizations to create the **Autorité des marchés financiers**. The CVMQ's activities have been assumed from within the Autorité.

Any formal correspondence submitted through SEDAR by the Québec commission prior to February 1, 2004 will still show their previous name. Any formal correspondence submitted on or after February 1, 2004 will be amended to indicate their new name.

This name is indicated in the Submitter column of the main Filing Management screen. Refer to section 7.4 of the SEDAR Filer User's Guide on how to have this column displayed on your Filing Management screen.

The Québec commission's bank account name will also be amended to reflect their new name, concurrent with this code update.

2. Filing subtype deleted

The “Notice” filing subtype and all underlying document types have been deleted from the “Resale of Securities (MI 45-102)” filing type as a result of the new Multilateral Instrument 45-102.

3. New document types

New document types have been added to the filing types “Interim Certificates” and “Annual Certificates” to facilitate the filing of transition documents:

- ◆ Form 52-109FT2 –Certification of Interim Filings – CEO
- ◆ Form 52-109FT2 –Certification of Interim Filings – CFO

- ◆ Form 52-109FT1 –Certification of Annual Filings – CEO
- ◆ Form 52-109FT1 –Certification of Annual Filings – CFO
