

SEDAR® Subscriber Update

March 26, 2010

Code Update (Version 008.013.001)

A SEDAR code update is scheduled for Monday, April 5, 2010.

You are encouraged to obtain the code update as soon as possible on or after April 5, 2010 by following these procedures:

1. Start the SEDAR program;
2. Select File menu; and
3. From the File menu, select Receive items from SEDAR server.

This method will help make sure that the application is updated and ready for your use before you actually have to perform any business functions.

This code update will bring the SEDAR client application up to Version 008.013.001.

Once the code update has been downloaded, close the SEDAR program and follow the instructions below to execute the code update:

1. Click the Start button located at the bottom left corner of the screen;
2. Select Programs; and
3. From the Program menu, select SEDAR and then select Code Update.

TMP Filings

All filings that have been saved but not submitted (shown as TMP on your Filing Management screen) should be either submitted by Thursday, April 1, 2010 or deleted. To delete any TMP filings, highlight the project and select File/ Remove Unsubmitted Filing(s).

Summary of Code Update Changes

1. Commission Fee Description Changes

Ontario Securities Commission

Changes to Ontario Fees:

Amendments to OSC Rule 13-502 Fees and Companion Policy 13-502CP Fees become effective Monday, April 5, 2010.

The following list summarizes changes to the OSC fee table in SEDAR:

1. Changes to all Corporate Finance participation fees.
(Codes: PI2210 to PI2219, PI2220 and PI2230 to PI2239).
2. Changes to various Prospectus fees: Now \$3,250 (up from \$3,000) and \$650 per investment fund (up from \$600). (Codes: AI4A10, AI4A30 and AR4A4B).
3. The additional fee of \$2,000 in connection with a long-form prospectus of a resource issuer accompanied by engineering reports (technical reports) will also apply in connection with the other forms of prospectus. (Code: AI4A20).
4. A new fee of \$3,250 for review of certain linked note supplements. (Code: AI4A50). Prospectus supplement in relation to a specified derivative (as defined in NI 44-102 Shelf Distributions) for which the amount payable is determined with reference to the price, value or level of an underlying interest that is unrelated to the operations or securities of the issuer.
5. Changes to Take-over Bid and Formal Course Issuer Bid fees: Now \$4,000 (up from \$3,000) (Code: AI4G10).
6. Changes to fees for applications filed in SEDAR under filing type Applications (NI 81-102): Now \$3,250 per section (up from \$3,000), maximum \$5,000 plus \$2,000 if (i) neither the applicant, (ii) issuer of which the applicant is a wholly-owned subsidiary, nor (iii) the fund manager of the applicant is subject to, or expected to become subject to participation fees. (Code: AI4E10).

Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission

Several filing fees required by the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission will be clarified or changed effective April 1, 2010.

Filing fees for technical reports filed under NI 43-101 and oil and gas reports filed under NI 51-101 will be \$100.00 per report. This is a clarification of existing requirements.

Filing fees for annual information forms filed by an issuer will be \$500.00, except for an annual information form filed under National Instrument 81-101 Mutual Fund Prospectus Disclosure, for which no fee is payable.

The fee schedule displayed on SEDAR will not reflect these changes until Monday, April 5th, 2010. Issuers filing annual information forms on April 1, 2010 should ignore the SEDAR fee schedule displayed for annual information forms, and apply the new fee schedule amount of \$500.00.

2. Stock Exchange reference “CNSX”

The list of Stock Exchanges (or Markets) on the Reporting and Markets tab of the Other Issuer profile type has been updated to reflect the current “CNSX” reference. Any existing profile that previously referenced “CNQ” has been updated to show “CNSX”.

The issuer’s corresponding profile supplement in SEDI has also been updated to show “CNSX”.
