Security Issue with Adobe Reader

CDS INC. would like to inform subscribers of a security issue with Adobe Reader. A flaw exists in a plug-in that enables Acrobat users to view PDF files within web browsers. This could allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary JavaScript into a browser session.

To avoid this issue, please follow these steps to open PDF documents outside of your browser:

- Open Adobe Reader 6 or 7, as applicable
- Click on "Edit"
- Click on "Preferences"
- Select "Internet"
- Remove check-mark from "Display PDF in browser"
